ADJOURNMENT

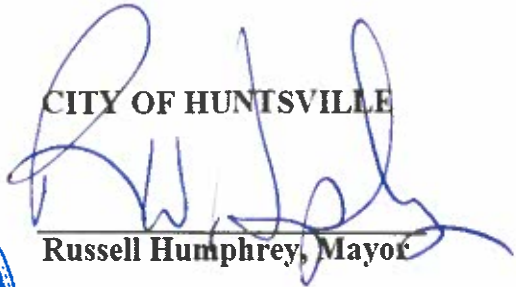
Mayor Humphrey adjourned the meeting without objection at 5:17 p.m.
